Did you know that the Harlem Riot of 1935 was caused by a rumor? A young man was caught shoplifting by a store clerk and was told he would be beaten for his actions. In response, the man bit the clerk on the hand, police were called and an ambulance came. Meanwhile, a rumor began to spread that the store clerk had beat the young man. This sparked great outrage among the residents of Harlem and began what is known as one of the first "modern" race riots of Harlem.

We all know the pain a rumor can cause. This Sunday as we continue our study in the Book of Acts, we're going to see how a rumor almost cost Paul his life. For two years Paul had his sights set on Jerusalem. When he arrived there, he came to see that what the Holy Spirit had been speaking to him came to fruition.
