During a visit to Jerusalem in the 1880s, British Major-General Charles Gordon, a godly man, discovered what he believed to be Christ's tomb. In effort to prove it was Christ's tomb, he took a handful of soil from the floor of the tomb and put it in a jar. He sent the jar to some chemists and had them test the soil for any trace of decomposition. The analysis found that there was no trace of decay in the soil sample from the tomb.

We need to share the message of the empty tomb with our friends, family, neighbors and people we encounter in our community. This Sunday we celebrate the risen Savior!
